### INSPECTION REPORT

The inspection team of the State Medical Faculty of West Bengal (SMFWB) visited Kshudiram Bose College of Pharmacy\_Purba Medinipur [PCI-6658], on 15.11.2025 to assess the infrastructural and academic facilities required for conducting the Diploma in Pharmacy Course.

For the Academic Year 2025–2026, the institute submitted the Decision Letter dated 17.08.2025 issued by the Pharmacy Council of India (PCI), wherein approval was granted for conducting the Diploma in Pharmacy course with an intake capacity of 60 students under the aegis of SMFWB.

During the inspection, it was observed that the library lacks the Indian Pharmacopoeia (2022 edition), which is an essential reference book for the course. Additionally, several important textbooks were found to be insufficient in number. The college requires 20 copies of the Pharmacology textbook by K.D. Tripathi, 10 copies of the Dispensing Pharmacy textbook by Cooper and Gunn, and 5 copies of the Pharmaceutics textbook by Lachman and Lieberman. It was further noted that only one copy of Goodman and Gilman's Pharmacology is available, whereas additional copies are recommended to meet academic needs. The inspectors have advised the institution to procure these essential books at the earliest to comply with PCI norms and to ensure adequate library resources for students.

*After a thorough assessment, the Members of the Inspection Committee of the State Medical Faculty of West Bengal, acting as the Examining Authority, as accorded by the Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi (PCI), concluded that the institute must take immediate corrective measures to address the deficiencies as articulated herein above.*

*These actions are essential to ensure compliance with the prescribed infrastructural and academic standards as enshrined by the Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi (PCI), required for the effective implementation of the Diploma in Pharmacy course under the State Medical Faculty of West Bengal.*

*The State Medical Faculty of West Bengal shall not be held responsible if the concerned institute failed and neglected to carry out corrective measures as pointed out herein above.*

*The concerned institute is required to let Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi (PCI) and State Medical Faculty of West Bengal (SMFWB) know about your compliance positively within a time frame of two to three months from the date of receipt of this report.*
